

28 craft villages are connected where respective craft trainings have been imparted to them to make their clusters more functional





600+ artisans are registered with us and nearly 19 SHG's were formed and the bank accounts are digitally linked where the remunerations of their skills are credited to them through digital banking

80% women artisans have been trained trough various training programs to make them self reliant







In association with Digital Empowerment Program (DEF) and Creative Dignity (CD) arranged one digital program for artisans to impart the training of all digital know how and its effective implementation

28 training programs were conducted in different crafts, one of which was with MAVIM (Mahila Arthik Vikas Mahamandal) where training of Basket making was imparted to them

Kolhapur Traditional Jewelery Clusters CFC (Common Facility Centre) Under Construction

The project is sanctioned Under SFURTI scheme by KVIC, Ministry of MSME, in which a building of 3000 sq.ft is being constructed with 1500 sq. ft on each floor. All the machines are installed at the first floor whereas, second floor is meant for trainings of the artisans. other facilities like separate toilet blocks are also provided considering their health and hygiene aspects.
